

## UNIFORM POLICY

J. W. Seabrook Elementary is a uniform school. Students are expected to be in uniform attire every school day. Our School Improvement Team has worked hard to provide students with several color options for school uniforms. Please review our uniform policy carefully.

**SHIRTS:** White, Black, Navy Blue, Light Blue, Burgundy/Red, Yellow or Gold polo (long or short sleeve, with a collar), or turtleneck; **NO brand name logos.** Seabrook school logos are permitted.

**Slacks/Shorts/Skirts/Capris/Jumpers:** Twill or cotton, solid Khaki Tan, Navy Blue, or Black color.

**Belts:** Students are highly encouraged to wear a Black or Brown belt.

**Shoes:** Athletic shoes; **NO** boots, sandals, or flats.

**Socks/Tights:** White or dark solid color.

**Sweaters:** White, Navy Blue, Black, Light Blue, Burgundy/Red, Yellow or Gold.

**Sweatshirts:** White, Navy Blue, Black, Light Blue, Burgundy/Red, Yellow or Gold; **NO brand logos.**

### **Guidelines:**

- No midriff shirts
- No open-toed or open heeled shoes will be allowed (must not have lights and must be suitable for PE). No tennis shoes with wheels.
- Skirts, skorts, jumpers, and shorts must be knee-length. Worn at or below fingertip length when standing.
- Sweaters must be totally solid in color.
- If a sweater is not being worn, it may not be tied around a student's waist.
- No "sagging" of pants.
- No hip-hugger slacks permitted
- No jeans of any type of denim may be worn even if it is tan or navy colored. Casual dress slacks only. No jeans with holes.
- No overalls are permitted.
- No unnatural colors or distracting hairstyles will be permitted. Hair appearance should not be a disruption to the school learning environment.
- Distracting, oversized jewelry may not be worn.
- Outerwear coats may not be worn in the building during the school day.
- Head coverings (hats, caps, etc.) and cold weather wear are not to be worn inside the building.
